FAQ'S

Can we trial a lesson?

All potential new dancers are encouraged to trial a lesson first. Head online to book your space or contact the office.

Whats best to wear for dance classes?

Dancers to wear their Doyle Academy shirt and shorts for each class. We recommend socks and sneakers for the first term. Hair to be tied up & off the face and neck.

What should we bring to dance classes?

A labeled drink bottle, dancing shoes and a small bag to keep these all in.

Do we need the uniform?

Yes. Dancers will need to in addition to the t shirt received with registration, purchase additional items to complete their class uniform.

During the year, what do we work towards?

All classes work towards the TIDA of NZ and CLRG syllabus. Dancers have the opportunity to participate in their first year in local dance to the music events and class competitions. We also partake in grade exams and our biannual show.

Does my child have to do competitions?

No. Dancers are given the opportunity to attend an additional class once they are ready for the hard shoe. From here they can choose to be non competitive or compete at a local level.

Who can watch the classes?

For the first term, our beginners classes parents/caregivers have the option to stay and watch. Generally after Term 1, our classes will be closed to spectators.
